- In 2012/13 there were 3,093 community and voluntary organisations, co-operatives and social enterprises in Manchester.
- 2 In 2012/13 the total income of the sector was £477 million.
- Medium and large organisations receive 95% of the total sector income.
- 4 1,987 organisations are micro (with an annual income under £10 thousand).
- There are 94,300 volunteers in the sector.
- 6 Volunteers give 370,000 hours each week.
- 7 The contribution of volunteers in the sector is valued at £332 million each year.
- 8 The sector employs 12,400 full time equivalent paid staff.
