What will I learn?

The sessions can be planned to meet your needs but could include:

- Presentation skills
- Writing a CV and job application
- Project planning
- How to write up a project idea
- Responding to a commission
- How to budget
- How to register as self-employed
- Promoting your work online

The sessions will also give you:

- Advice and guidance
- Tips about how creative people make and share work in the UK
- Links to Greater Manchester-based arts organisations and support networks.

Am I eligible to apply?

- You must be aged 19 or over
- You must be living in Greater Manchester
- You must have permission to work in the UK
- You must be unemployed/not working
- You cannot be studying full-time

When and where will it take place?

From May to September 2020, CAN are offering free one-to-one and small group sessions by phone and online. These sessions will take place during the week at a time that is suitable for you.

Further group sessions may be available once the Coronavirus lockdown ends.

When is the deadline for applications?

You can apply any time before the end of July 2020. However, we have limited places so the sooner you apply, the more chance you will have of getting a place, and the sooner you can start. We are likely to run a second course later in the year, so if we fill all available places, we can add you to a waiting list.
