Aged 14-19? Join CFCCA's Youthlab: 2018 Summer School with a week of free workshops and arty visits and gain a Bronze Arts Award

Youthlab is Centre for Chinese Contemporary Art's on going activity for local young people aged 14-19. This includes an annual summer school and regular term time free workshop programmes and exhibition opportunities.

The Youthlab: 2018 Summer School will run from Monday 6 – Friday 10 August, with a view to roll on in to an ongoing group from September onwards if we have enough interested participants. For the summer series, participants will work towards an Arts Award Bronze.

Arts Award supports young people to grow as artists and arts leaders, inspiring them to connect with & take part in the wider arts world. As part of Youthlab, you will create a portfolio or arts log that shows off your creativity as well as achieving a recognised award to put on your CV.

Throughout the Summer School you will take part in workshops, visit art galleries, research things that interest you and share your skills with others and showcase your work at the gallery as part of our exhibitions programme!

Youthlab will take place at CFCCA in Manchester's Northern Quarter. Five one day sessions with a lunch break, 10am – 3pm. The week will include a small number of off site visits to see local artist studios and visit Madlab, Manchester's 'digital laboratory' for a digital learning and making session.

CFCCA can offer a travel bursary of up to £5 per session per participant for those who take public transport to the gallery to attend Youthlab. Please present your valid bus/tram/train tickets at the start of each session.
