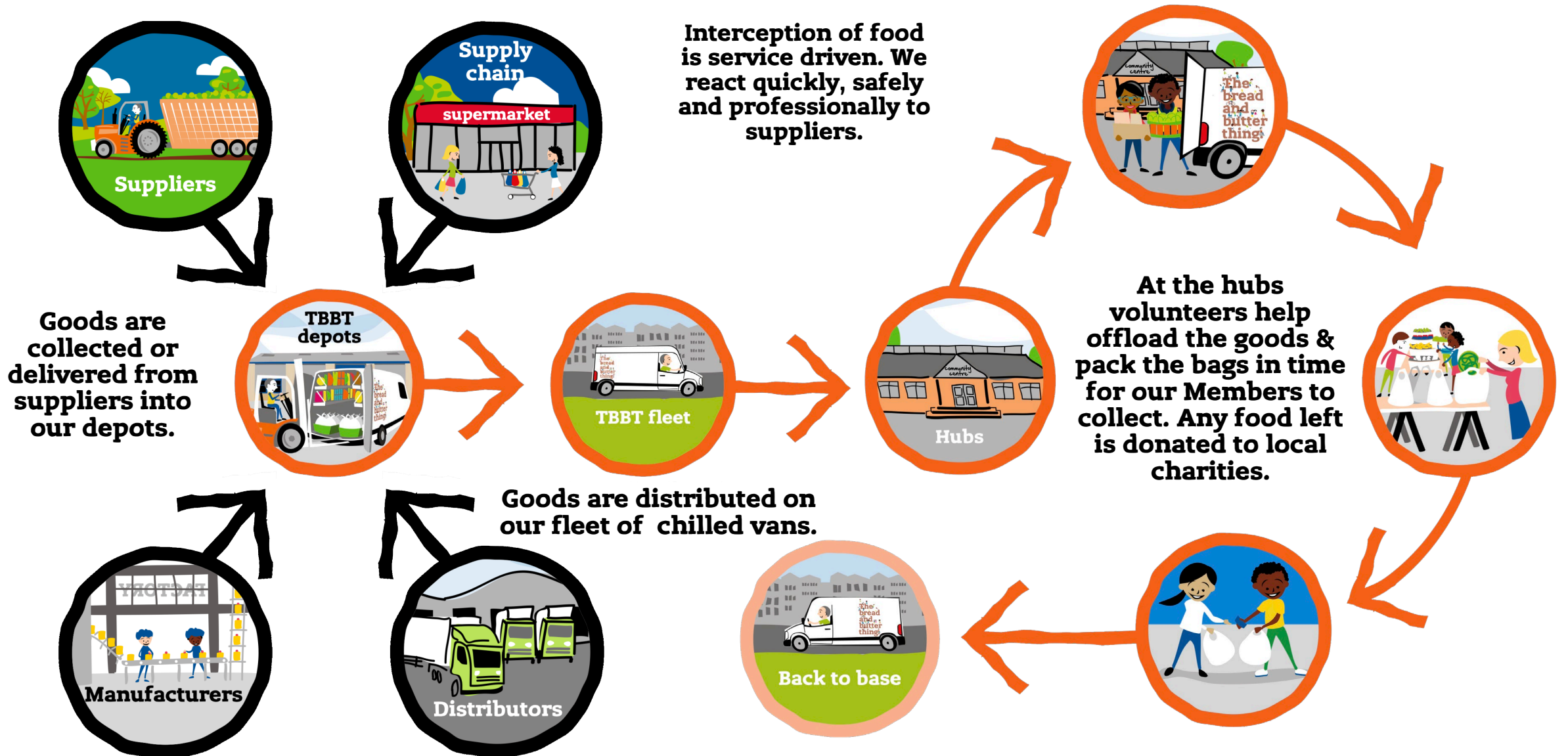

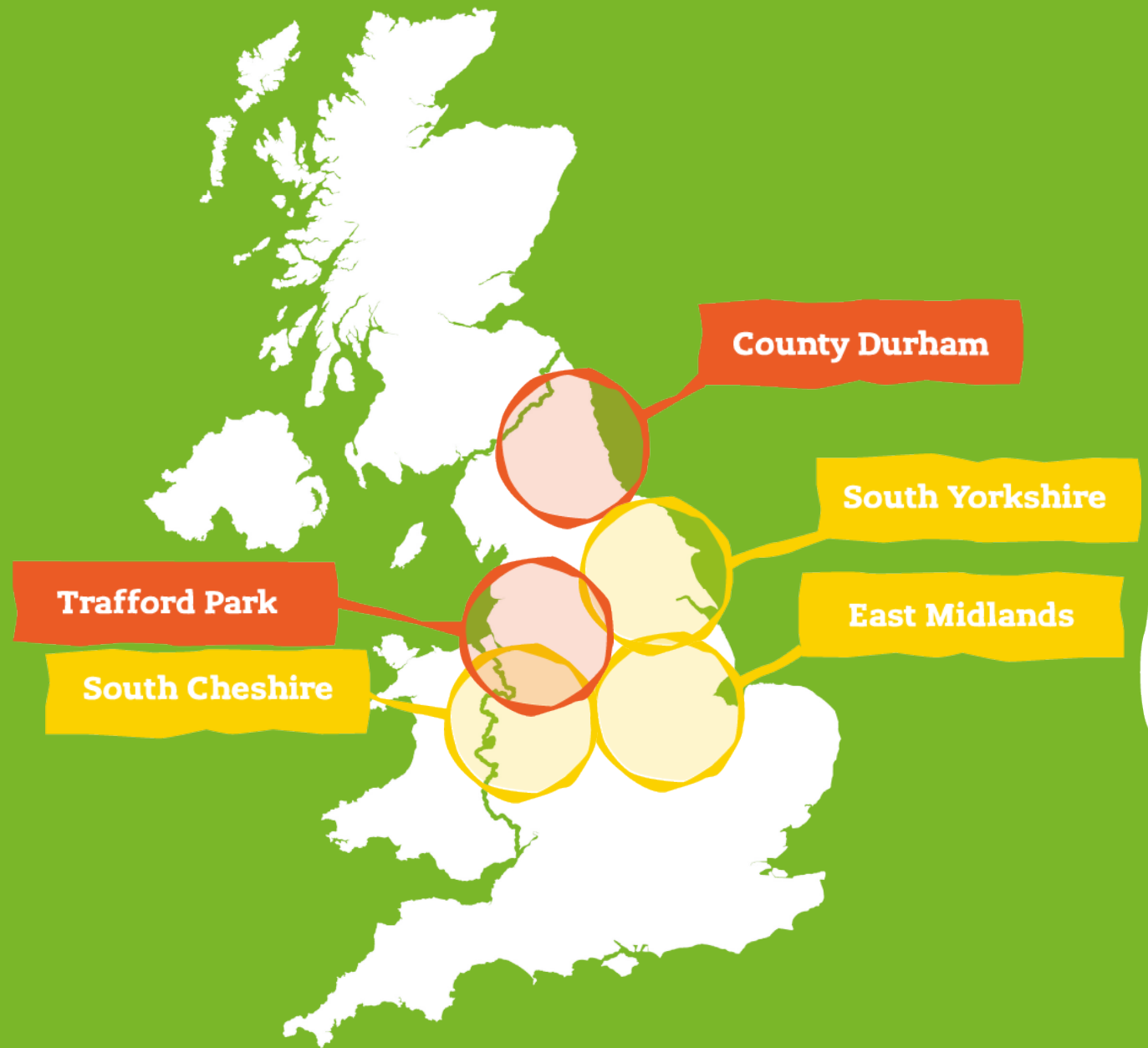

# 2022 Impact

In 2022, TBBT members collectively saved more than **£4.8 million** on their food budgets.

**77% families worry less about running out of food**

**96% feel comfortable shopping with TBBT**

**72% members have better access to affordable fruit and veg.**

**5000 tonnes of food was redistributed to our communities**

**Equivalent to a massive 12 million meals worth.**

**That's 9.5m tonnes of CO2 saved.**

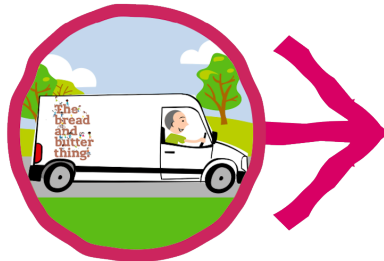
