

Neighbourhood Study

You may be contacted by a student nurse from the University of Manchester in the coming weeks as the new first years will be completing a neighbourhood study.

We want the students to find out about what is available in Greater Manchester communities to support people's health and well-being before they start clinical placements.

Groups of 10-11 students have been assigned local areas to explore and will be visiting the neighbourhood and contacting local services.

If a student phones or visits you, we just ask that you share any information you have about your service and direct them to any other relevant contacts. Students will be professional and courteous; if you are not able to help when they contact you please just tell them.

There is no expectation that students will spend time 'working' in any service. They are gathering information to share with fellow students and if you can meet with a small group of students that would be great, but we know this may not be possible.

Hopefully their findings will inform their future work and other nurses in practice.

- Assets – what formal and informal health & social support is available?
