| Category 5 | Clean & Green Award For those who have played a key role in cleaning up or improving the look of our community. It might be someone who looks after a small patch of land or organises regular litter picks. A true eco-warrior! |
| Category 6 | Making a Difference Award This special award could be for anything, from helping a sick relative to helping older people or those with a disability. It might be someone who has gone above and beyond for their local community. |
| Category 7 | People's Champion Award This award recognises an individual who, over time, has demonstrated remarkable levels of personal dedication and commitment to public service and to the community of Gorton. |
