You can access this scheme if:

- You are over 18
- Have been a victim of domestic abuse
- You want to stay in your home
- It is safe for you to stay in your home with better security
- You have a legal right to live in your home
- The perpetrator has no legal right to enter your home
- You live within the Manchester City Council area

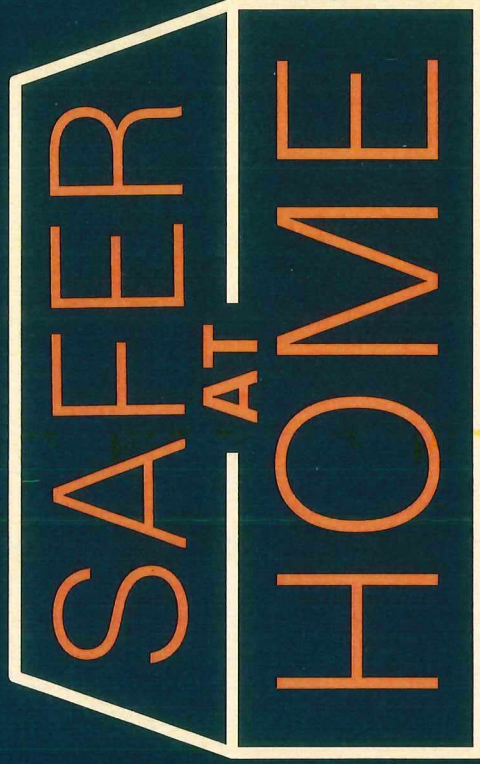

What is Safer at Home?

If you are experiencing domestic abuse, the Safer at Home scheme will support you to:

- Have an assessment of your home by an experienced security professional
- Have extra security fitted to your home

We understand that people who have experienced domestic abuse, might not want to leave their home, family, friends and community.

If it is safe for you to stay at home with greater security, then this scheme might be for you.
