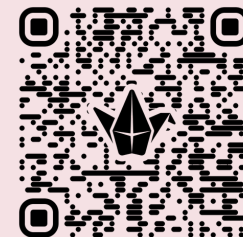

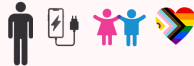

### BOOTH CENTRE

- Stop E: 135 bus to Bury
- ride 4 stops till Park Place
- walk back on yourself until at Park St
- walk down until at Pimblett St

### MUSTARD TREE

- Walk from PG straight up Oldham St (between five guys Morrisons)
- Carry on straight for 15 minutes until Mustard tree
- Opposite WING YIP

• When you get to JULIA Hair & cosmetics turn right down Dale St

- Ride 10 stops till Boundary Lane
- Walk on Greenheys Lane till you see Darul Amaan Mosque
- Turn on to Charles Halle Road (Between Heineken factory and Mosque)
- Cornerstones on Denmark Road.
