You can bid between £500 - £3,000.

An information meeting is to be held on 2nd December 2014 where more information can be given around this event. This will be held at Longsight Library, between 6.00pm - 7.30pm.

1 Who can/cannot apply for the funding?

Un-constituted (3 persons plus sponsor), constituted, community organisation, youth and school groups, not for profit organisations and sports groups can all apply for funding as long as they benefit the people/communities of Longsight. All bids made must benefit within the Longsight Council Ward areas. (Please see attached map)

Statutory agencies, private businesses, faith groups and individuals can not apply for funding.

2 What can/can't we bid for?

Any bid's made must benefit the people of Longsight, all bids must be legal and self-sustainable. Bids must all be for projects that are going to be on going, and NOT just a one off event.

You CAN NOT put funding application in for maintenance of items, any illegal activity, anything political or exclusive and nothing that will be prejudicial.

3 How much can we bid for?

You can bid for a minimum of £500 and a maximum of £3,000.

4 Will we be given support on application?

Support will be provided for applicant's who wish, this will be on 2nd December 2014, at Longsight Library, Community Room, 519 Stockport Road, Manchester M12 4NE between 6.00pm - 7.30pm.

5 How will bidding process work on Saturday 24th January 2015?

Successful applicants will need to do a 3 minute pitch at the Participatory Budgeting event, at the Sanam Buffet and Banqueting Hall, 587 Stockport Road, Longsight, Manchester, M13 0RX. There must only be up to 3 people doing the pitch on stage and they should be mentioned on the application if possible. Once all pitches are complete, the members of the community who attend on the day will vote for the project they want to fund.

The bidding party will have 3 allocated seats to ensure fairness of attendance.
