


Interception of food is service driven. We react quickly, safely and professionally to suppliers.

charities.








## 2022 Impact

In 2022, TBBT members collectively saved more than £4.8 million on their food budgets.

77% families worry less about running out of food

96% feel comfortable shopping with TBBT

72% members have better access to affordable fruit and veg.

5000 tonnes of food was redistributed to our communities

Equivalent to a massive 12 million meals worth.

That's 9.5m tonnes of CO2 saved.

# Volunteering Opportunities
