Who is this course for?	This course is for you if you want to develop your digital skills for work
	and at home.
Entry requirements	You should be able to speak, read, and write English confidently. You
	should have some experience of using digital devices and the internet
	but lack secure basic digital skills. You will need access to a device
	(tablet, laptop, computer) at home. You may be eligible to loan a device
	for the duration of the course.
What will I learn on this	You'll learn how to use different devices and applications for handling
course?	information, creating and editing, communicating, and transacting while
	remaining safe, secure and responsible online. You can gain a
	qualification on this course. Assessment will be exam based.
How will I learn?	Sessions run twice a week. One session will be in the IT Room (with
	social distancing measures applied) and the second session by
	distance. Your tutor will guide and support you through the course
	requirements by setting you remote distance learning tasks through our
	Google for Education and Google Meets. Video guides will be available.

	personalised and supportive atmosphere whether you are in the
	classroom or learning at home.
