Manchester has ambitious and exciting plans to build a Local Care Organisation (LCO) <u>http://www.manchesterccgs.nhs.uk/the-lco-prospectus</u>. This is a great opportunity to build something new from the start which will make a difference to the challenges we face for the health and social opportunity of the communities we serve. Manchester City Council is making a substantial commitment to the LCO and will include the broadest range possible of social care services and functions.

The level of commitment from the council and the ambition was a key factor in my decision to join the work in Manchester. I think this presents one of the best opportunities in England and this will be an exciting challenge for the successful

candidate to influence how social care and wider community assets will feature in the work of the LCO.
