1 Who can/cannot apply for the funding?

Un-constituted (3 persons plus sponsor), constituted, community organisation, youth and school groups, not for profit organisations and sports groups can all apply for funding as long as they benefit the people/communities of Wythenshawe. All bids made must benefit within the M22/M23 postal code areas.

Statutory agencies, private businesses, faith groups and individuals can not apply for funding.

2 What can/can't we bid for?

Any bid's made must benefit the people of Wythenshawe, all bids must be legal and self-sustainable. Bids must all be for projects that are going to be on going, and NOT just a one off event.

You CAN NOT put funding application in for maintenance of items, any illegal activity, anything political or exclusive and nothing that will be prejudicial.

3 How much can we bid for?

You can bid for a minimum of £500 and a maximum of £3,000.

4 Will we be given support on application?

Support will be provided for applicant's who wish, this will be on Thursday 23rd October, at Lifestyle Centre, Portway, Woodhouse Park, M22 1QW between 1800-1930 hours.

5 How will bidding process work on Saturday 22nd November 2014?

On 22nd November 2014, successful applicants will need to do a 3 minute pitch at the Participatory Budgeting event, in Lifestyle centre, Portway, Woodhouse Park. There must only be up to 3 people doing the pitch on stage and they should be mentioned on the application if possible. Once all pitches are complete, the members of the community who attend on the day will vote for the project they want to fund. The bidding party will have 3 allocated seats to ensure fairness of attendance.
